The next big track to be synched to the smash hit show, Packed To The Rafters is "GOOD TIMES" by Latch Key Kid. The track will feature on promo spots for the show for the whole of Season 1, a total of 19 weeks with 'Good Times' featuring in the opening episode.

Latch Key Kid is Gavin Heaney, a Californian singer-songwriter that has been making a name for himself on the road with The Beautiful Girls in the US and Canada as well as Jack Johnson and Donovan Frankenreiter.

One of Latch Key Kid's major accomplishments has been his ability to unlock the doors of Hollywood and license his music in Film, Television and Advertising. Most notably, the single, "Good Times" was licensed for the trailer, opening credit sequence and soundtrack of the DreamWorks' film, I Love You Man (2009). In 2008 the song "Good Times" was also licensed in Coca-Cola's Jinx commercial that first aired during Super Bowl XLII and reached an audience of 97 million viewers. Latch Key Kid songs also appeared in Rogers Wireless (Canada) and Gottschalks Department Stores (US) commercials and on a myriad of TV shows such as The Hills (MTV), Ghost Whisperer, The Amazing Race (CBS), Men In Trees (ABC) and Road Trip Nation (PBS).
